Dear Supporters and Friends,

I started off the year the first week of January preaching at Thousand Hills Church in Amsterdam, pastored by Sebastiaan Van Wessem, to help them launch a prayer emphasis of several weeks. A week later I preached a weekend evangelistic outreach in Rome, Italy at the largest AG church in Rome, pastored by Salvatore Cusumano and saw more than sixty come to Christ. I also preached in a suburb of Rome at a mission outreach in an area where there was no Pentecostal church. My friend Giorgio Botturi had a burden several years ago to begin that ministry. I went with him to that area back then and we joined together in prayer that the mission would become reality. *Now it is!*

In February, I traveled to Singapore to preach their missions faith promises for the first six months of the year. This great missionary church is touching the world in an incredible way. Pastor Danny Han told me when I arrived that their missions faith promises were down to just \$400,000—per month! With the new initiatives they have planned, they needed them to be at \$600,000 per month. They have incredible faith, passion, and commitment to reach the world.



I just returned from preaching at the General Council of the Assemblies of God of Vanuatu, in the South Pacific.

I preached for five nights in the open air to about 4,000 each night, and after every service almost 1,000 came to the altar to seek God (pictured below). Missionary Bryan Webb interpreted for me for each service. He is one of the best interpreters I've had anywhere in the world. The Spirit moved in all of the services and the people were so responsive. God certainly blessed this event.



The Vanuatu AG is committing themselves to reach the lost in every island of Vanuatu. This is a great challenge because, for instance, on the island of Espiritu Santo alone, with 40,000 people, they speak more than a hundred languages.

Missionary Ron Killingbeck who is now 80 years of age and very visually impaired accompanied me on the flights from Los Angeles to Sydney, Australia, and then on to Vanuatu because he couldn't travel by himself. He was the first AG missionary to Vanuatu many years ago and it was wonderful to see how the thousands of people that are serving the Lord there honored him at the General Council for first bringing the gospel to them.

I would appreciate your prayers next month as I return to Italy to preach their National Sunday School Convention in Fiuggi, at which pastors and Sunday school teachers from all over Italy will be in attendance. Pray for a powerful move of the Holy Spirit. A couple of weeks later, I travel to Cuba.
